3-HTML Elements.

An **HTML element** is defined by a starting tag. If the element contains other content, it ends with a closing tag, where the element name is preceded by a forward slash.

4- HTML Element Category

All the HTML elements can be categorized into two categories.

Block Level Element.

They all start on their own new line, and anything that follows them appears on its own new line.

, <h1>, <h2>, <h3>, <h4>, <h5>, <h6>, , , <dl>, , <hr />, <blockquote>, and <address> elements are all block level elements.

• Inline Level Element.

Inline elements, on the other hand, can appear within sentences and do not have to appear on a new line of their own.

The , <i>, <u>, , , <sup>, <sub>, <big>, <small>, , <ins>, , <code>, <cite>, <dfn>, <kbd>, and <var> elements are all inline elements.
