3-HTML Elements.

An **HTML element** is defined by a starting tag. If the element contains other content, it ends with a closing tag, where the element name is preceded by a forward slash.

<P>.....</p>

<h1>.....</h2>

<div>.....</div>

4- HTML Element Category

All the HTML elements can be categorized into two categories.

- **Block Level Element.**

They all start on their own new line, and anything that follows them appears on its own new line.

<p>, <h1>, <h2>, <h3>, <h4>, <h5>, <h6>, , , <dl>, <pre>, <hr />, <blockquote>, and <address> elements are all block level elements.

- **Inline Level Element.**

Inline elements, on the other hand, can appear within sentences and do not have to appear on a new line of their own.

The , <i>, <u>, , , <sup>, <sub>, <big>, <small>, , <ins>, , <code>, <cite>, <dfn>, <kbd>, and <var> elements are all inline elements.
